

LEPTO VACCINE WAIVER

Dogs who come into contact with one type of microorganism, a bacteria called Leptospira, may develop a disease called leptospirosis. Leptospirosis is a bacterial infection that targets the kidneys and liver, this disease can be fatal.

Dogs can become infected if their mucous membranes or a wound comes into contact with infected urine, urinecontaminated soil, water, food, or bedding; through a bite from an infected animal; by eating infected tissue; or during birth.

Vaccination for the prevention of leptospirosis should be strongly considered for most dogs in North America as the disease can be life-threatening, is endemic in much of the continent, and is zoonotic. Lepto vaccine is a 1 year vaccine.
